Name of event: Lecture Series

Saturday, January 30, 2010 at 1pm. The Marine Mammal Stranding Center will discuss the winter population of seals and the work they do to rehabilitate injured marine life that has been brought to them.

Saturday, February 6, 2010 at 1pm. The U.S. Lifesaving Service and LBI presented by Tim Hart, Director of the Ocean County Cultural and Heritage Commission. This lecture is about William Newell, considered the father of the Lifesaving Service which subsequently became part of the Coast Guard. The lecture will also discuss the Services extensive system on LBI.

Saturday, February 27, 2010 at 1pm. Brett Frank of the NJLHS will talk about FRESNEL LENSES and the lens at Barnegat Lighthouse. Mr. Frank has been involved with Lighthouse for over 20 years and is deemed an expert in his field.

Saturday, March 6, 2010 is a special treat for BIRDERS and those who would like to learn about bird watching. At 10am the Southern Ocean Birding Group will be on hand to set up scopes on the jetty for bird viewing after a short talk by Susan Puder, President of the organization. At 1pm. Fred Lesser of the Ocean County Parks Department will talk about the Birds of Barnegat followed by a walk on the jetty.

Saturday, March 20, 2010 at 1pm. THE fossil Story, What Fossils Reveal About The Past. This lecture describes how fossils form and all the information that can be derived to understand the earth's past. Presented by Ray Young, retired science teacher and amateur paleontologist.

Saturday, April 24, 2010 at 1pm. The History of Barnegat Lighthouse. A comprehensive fact filled presentation by Professor Alex Butrym a member of the staff at Barnegat Lighthouse State Park.

Saturday, May 22, 2010 at 1pm The Life of a Clam, presented by Rick Bushnell of Reclam The Bay. An in depth lifeline of the clam from birth to harvest. You won't believe some of this presentation but you will be fascinated.

We will also have a discussion of Sailing Around the World by none other than our own Nobel Prize in Physics winner George Smith and his mate Janet Murphy. Date to be announced.
